## FEATHER FILLED CUSHIONS

Feather mix cushions are soft and supportive allowing the body to nestle into the cushioning. Soft, plump cushions that look good drape well and have that casual "lived in look". They give that soft inviting look and feel to lounges with no harsh straight edges. With the use of chambers and/or the addition of foam cores, feather cushions can be designed to give the right feel and support in all the right places.

## FEATHER WRAP CUSHIONS

Using foam/Dacron cores wrapped in a feather mix has created cushions that combine the best characteristics of feather and block foam - the softness, support and comfort of feather mix combined with the stability and resilience of block foam.

## CARING FOR FEATHER CUSHIONS

Feather mix cushions have special care requirements. It is important to EXERCISE your cushions by plumping them up regularly to maintain their bulk and to give them a longer life. Your cushions can also be put out in the sun to air. When you remove their covers, it is also a good idea to vacuum the cushions to remove any feathers that may have escaped.

# Fabric



### CARE OF FABRIC

When arranging your furniture, avoid direct sunlight, as prolonged exposure can cause colours to fade in furnishing fabrics. Care should also be taken to avoid furniture touching external walls or heating as this could cause problems of moisture build-up and/or scorching damage.

Take care to prevent sharp objects (e.g. children's sandal buckles, pets claws) from coming into contact with your furniture, as this may cause snagging or tearing of the fabric. Vacuum regularly (weekly) using low suction. Rotate reversible cushions regularly.

### CLEANING FABRIC

Professional furniture dry clean only recommended.

Professional application of Scotch guard recommended.

Do not Dry Clean. Do not wet filing. Do not spot clean. Do not rub.

### PILLING

Pilling can occur occasionally as a result of normal daily wear and should not be considered as a fault. Fiber pills can be removed by battery operated pilling tool available from most haberdashery stores.

### SLUBS

Slubs are a normal occurrence in linen fabrics and should not be considered as a fault.

# Timber



### BEECH

Common name for the Fagaceae, a family of trees and shrubs mainly of temperate and subtropical regions in the Northern Hemisphere. Highly valued throughout the world for hardwood timber. The tough, strong, easily worked wood is used for furniture, flooring, crating, and woodenware.

### BIRCH

Common name for some members of the Betulaceae. They are valued for their hardwood lumber. The close-grained hardwood of several of the trees is valued for furniture, flooring, and similar uses (in America, particularly that of the yellow birch).

### ALDER

Alder is a hot commodity. It used to be a poor boys maple, but with the advent of modern milling and kiln technology it has come into its own as a hardwood for cabinetry and furniture. It even supports a market for character wood using the knotty, stained and void containing boards that used to go to the chipper. It finishes beautifully with a light color and tight grain structure.

### OAK

Prized as the major source of hardwood lumber. The wood is durable, tough, and attractively grained; it is especially valued in shipbuilding and construction and for flooring, furniture

### FINISH & COLOUR

All products are hand finished ensuring each piece is distinctively different and possess unique characteristics. Due to these characteristics the colour and texture may vary from piece to piece and from the showroom samples, to ordered items. Every effort is made to achieve consistency of colour and texture. This however is not guaranteed.

### CARE OF TIMBER

#### RAW

Some timber used in our products is raw, and can only be cleaned with a damp cloth. Do Not use any cleaning products as these will leave marks. When placing objects on this surface please use a coaster or felt button. The characteristics of this furniture is designed to be worn and raw looking.

#### PAINTED OR LAQUERED

We recommend a high quality furniture polish used with a soft, clean cloth.
